New Hope is offering a camp this summer for all children three to six years old. The cost will be \$20 per day or \$90 per week, 9:00 A.M. to 1:00 P.M., Monday through Friday. We will offer many fun and exciting things for the children; we will spend a lot of time outside....sun screen and safe shoes are of great importance. The school will supply snacks. Children should bring a sack lunch with drink each day.

Each week of camp will have a fun theme. Wednesday of each week will be an outdoor water day; send your child with swim gear, including towel and use plenty of sunscreen. If a Wednesday is too rainy, we will try to have the water day on Thursday. Water days consist of a sprinkler, slip and slide, and/or water balloons. You may sign up for a specific themed week, all weeks, or a few days every week. The days you sign up for will be considered a commitment. Additional days/weeks may be added as spaces are available.

Choose your days and weeks from the table below. A registration fee of \$15 applies for students who attend summer camp that are not currently enrolled at NHCA. All students will need to have enrollment forms and updated medical history on file.

The following is a brief description of what your child might do during each theme.

Let's go camping!: Bring a flashlight and sleeping bag, we'll pitch a tent indoors or out (maybe both), sing camp songs, build a pretend fire, make s'mores (without a fire).

On Parade: Decorate boxes and bikes, make/play instruments, and have our own parade on Friday.

Winter in July: Study ice, use frozen paint, play in fake snow (bring mittens), build a "snow" man without snow, sing about Frosty.

Dinosaur Fun: Dig around for dinosaurs in the sandbox, discover how big dinosaurs were, scratch out a toy fossil with plastic bones

Under the Sea: Pretend to be a diver discovering beautiful fish, create an ocean bottle(bring an empty water bottle), learn about sharks and dolphins

Kid's Choice: Last week of camp before school starts, some water play, favorite activities from previous weeks, and whatever else the kids would like to do.

All weeks include plenty of outdoor time, so please apply sunscreen before coming to camp. You may send a bottle if re-application may be necessary. If possible, do not include peanut butter in your child's lunch. If your child's lunch should contain peanut butter or peanut products, please let me know so he/she is not seated near anyone with allergies. Please also let me know if your child has food allergies so I can plan accordingly and notify parents regarding lunch preparation if necessary.
